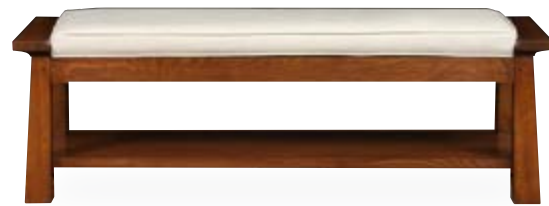
COMFORT WITH EVERY CURVE

CRAFTED FOR BEAUTY

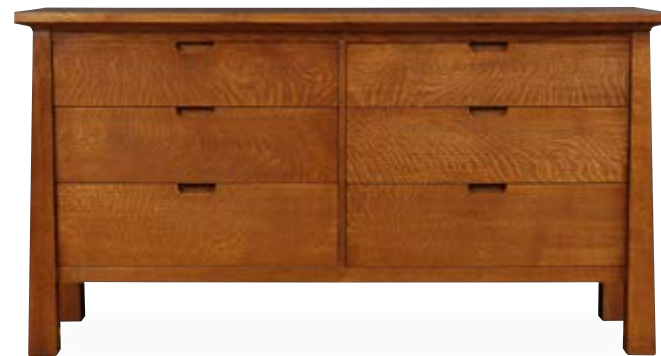

SOLID QUARTERSAWN WHITE OAK

Quartersawn American white oak produces boards of great strength, less likely to crack, check, or warp than flat-sawn timber and ideal for crafting furniture that will last for generations. Quartersawing also reveals the ray flake, a highly prized tiger-stripe pattern running across the grain that makes each piece of furniture unique.

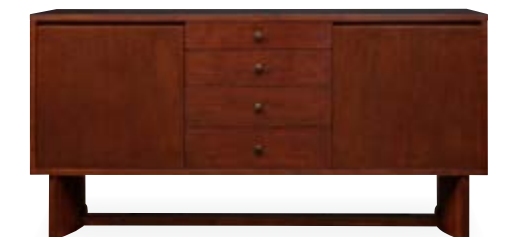


EXCEPTIONAL FROM EVERY ANGLE.

TIMELESS SEATING

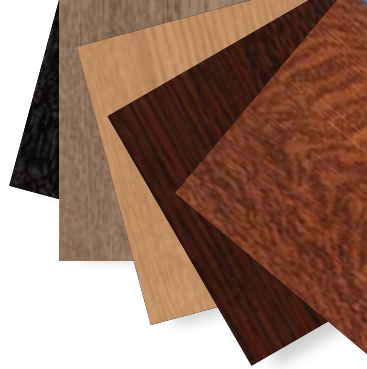

Harvey Ellis worked for Gustav Stickley in 1903. His influence is seen in the use of delicately shaped wood & metal inlays—and also the curved edges that lightened Stickley's designs. His designs remain some of the most beloved in our Arts and Crafts collection.
